



HOW TO RESIZE IMAGES FOR MY SHOPPING CART?

Following is the guide for editing image by using Image Resizer free software offered by Microsoft.

For Windows XP

1, You need download and install Microsoft's Image Resizer Powertoy for Windows XP at: <http://www.microsoft.com/windowsxp/downloads/powertoys/xppowertoys.msp>, Click on ImageResizer.ext at right side, you are downloading the file and click "open" when the "File Download Security Warning" window pops up. follow the wizards by click "next" to the end and click "finish" button.

2, Now, you've installed the microsoft Image Resizer program.

- Open up a view of your images using Windows Explorer or My Computer
- Select the image(s) you wish to resize
- RIGHT mouse click on the selected images
- In the dialog box that pops up, choose "Resize Pictures"
- Choose the size you want , you need click on "Advanced" button, choose "Custom", type in the size you prefer. you may calculate the length and width by divide a same number to smaller the current huge picture. ***The Length : Width has to keep the same ratio. for example: your digital picture is 1800*1350, you can reduce it to 1024*768, 800*600, 200*150, based on the ratio 4:3. the ratio is important to make sure the image is not twisted.

3. Copies of you new resized images (with a "(Custom) in the filename) will appear in the folder with your other images. then rename the file as you want.

for example: "testimage" becomes "testimage(Custom)". Now right click the image to rename the file to "testimage_t".

4,search on google for "rename a file in windows" for more information. please remember you can't use the huge image from the camera, you need resize it to 2 files. one for normal image, one for thumbnail image.

*The recommended sizes are : (400*300, 300*400) ; (200*150 or 150*200), you can do more testing for different numbers to see the exact

results.
